Legislative Report

In a recent discussion with Jonathan Mathers - the Legislative Director for Senator Springer, Texas Senate District 30 – he agreed that a "Definition of a Motorcycle" might be the best way to address the classification (and registration) of an Autocycle. In speaking with Texas House District 62 Representative, Reggie Smith, he also agreed that a definition of a motorcycle is long over-due – and will consider drafting a companion bill

next session. Rep Smith also committed to co-sponsoring a House Anti-Motorcycle Profiling bill next session – very similar to the substituted (87th) House Bill 1837. We have 150 House Districts and 31 Senate Districts in Texas. Contacting our legislators and committee members will be our greatest challenge next session – and it will require participation in every district! Texas bikers will need to work smarter, not harder. We can do this!

January 10th is the first day of the Texas 88th Legislative Session - nine months from now. That gives us a couple of months to finish strong on a federal anti-motorcycle profiling resolution – House Resolution 366. This House resolution has fewer cosponsors this session, as it did last session. Congressman Dan Crenshaw, from Texas District 2, is the latest cosponsor from Texas; if you are his constituent be sure to thank him. We are quickly approaching the 2nd half of this session, and it is time for this bill to gain some serious momentum! The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has a "Call to Action" link on their web page, and everyone should check it out; Take action here:

The new "Policy Engage" service appears to work great, and the form only takes a minute to complete; if your U.S. Rep already signed on as a co-sponsor, he/she will get a thank you letter! The MRF keeps track on which States make the most contacts, and, so far, Texas ranks #4 - with 124 people answering the call. Please, if you have not "Anti-Profiling answered the House Resolution 366 Call to Action" please do so now. Texas has 36 U.S. districts, but only 3 representatives are co-sponsors to H.Res. 366 - Michael Burgess (TX-26), Henry Cuellar (TX-28), and Dan Crenshaw (TX-2). Motorcycle profiling is illegal - TAKE ACTION https://mrf.org/federalhere: legislative-issues/.

DOERS VS SAYERS

I am sure you have heard it said before that the world is filled with "Doers" and "Sayers". Generally, Doers DO things and deliver results, and Sayers SAY they do things, but it is usually a Doer who will eventually get it done. Often, a Sayer will remind everyone else to do something, but will not get to do it themselves (ie., take action on a link, go to a meeting, etc.). We discussed this topic recently at an ABATE meeting and agreed that we too have our fair share of Sayers in our own motorcycle organization, in some chapters more than others. It seems like our tendencies are changing lately, and there are more Sayers than Doers! If our numbers don't add up, we may be the subjects of an excessive Sayers presence! We are our own biggest challenge, and we will need more Doers than Sayers if we are going to pass any motorcycle legislation next session. A perfect example is the Federal resolution House Resolution 366. In a Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) ranking of all States taking action on H. Res. 366 (Policy Engage; motorcycle profiling), Texas ranks 4th in the Country for contacting Congressional House reps with (only) 124 people taking action. We should take pride in Texas ranking in the "Top 5" in anything legislative, but I have my concerns about being ranked 4th. Three and four years ago, Texas was ranked #2 and #1 (respectfully) in the same MRF survey! Also, I believe that 124 bikers taking action on H.Res. 366 is a low number for Texas, and we can do better – but we are quickly running out of time. Let's double our numbers, and make Texas #1; be a "Doer", and take action on H.Res 366 here:
